Question & Answer

Q. Judith, I have bought some Super Sculpey and find that after it bakes there are little cracks in the clay. What am I doing wrong or is it just the SS. I did it like you do on your video without a lot of conditioning. I looked for a help line on your website but didn't see one in case the question was already answered. Most people talk about moonies, these are little cracks. Thank you for any help Shirley.

A. Dear Shirley - Use *Gel Quick Tite Super Glue* to rub into those cracks. Tiny ones will disappear - wipe off excess with make up sponge - immediately. Fine sanding will clean up if necessary. Check out my new hand video & make up video it shows "first aid" info for cracks & breaks. "The Sculpey Moonies" are those little moon-shaped chips under the surface of the clay. After make-up & bearding they are very hard to detect.
